



## **Information for New Infant Parents**

Dear Parents,

It was lovely to meet you and your wonderful boys in school last week. Just a few points to note before we meet again in September;

### **Return Date and School Hours:**

We begin our new school year on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> August. All of our new infants will start school at 8.55am and finish at 11.45am, until Friday 15<sup>th</sup> of September. After that the usual infant hours will apply; 8.55am - 1.45pm. Please note that the school gates open at 8.40am, boys can be dropped at the front door from this time and will be supervised in their classrooms. Boys can be collected again at the front door of the school.

### **Lunch:**

Students are provided with a hot lunch each day. We will send you a link in the coming weeks with the details of our lunch provider and you will be able to order a hot lunch for your son for his big lunch. Please also pack a piece of fruit for fruit break and a snack for small lunch. As per our healthy eating policy, boys are allowed one small treat on Fridays only. Please pack water for your son also and we don't advise using the screw top bottles, as they can leak and spill easily. Please ensure your son has a lunchbox that he can easily open and close independently.

### **Stationery and Books:**

As per the government's free primary school books scheme, all books, copies etc will be provided in September. However, we ask that students bring:

- A pencil case
- 5 pencils
- 2 rubbers
- 3 pritt sticks
- 2 whiteboard markers
- A pack of twistable colours

**Please label all belongings.**

Also, please ensure your son's school bag is big enough to hold his folder and belongings.

All pupils in the school pay €50 in September to cover insurance, photocopying, art and craft, etc. This can be paid to class teachers.

### **Uniforms:**

School tracksuits can be worn on PE days.

Ms Keane's PE days are Wednesdays and Fridays.

Ms. Lanigan's PE days are Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Please ensure that boys can independently secure their shoes - we recommend velcro straps for this age group.
